### INTERPROFESSIONAL EDUCATION

### INTERPROFESSIONAL PRACTICE

InterProfessional Practice (IPP) occurs when multiple service providers from different professional backgrounds provide comprehensive healthcare or educational services by working with individuals and their families, caregivers, and communities- to deliver the highest quality of care across settings.

### **OUR PROGRAM**

- Carle Auditory Oral School
  - Member of OPTIONSchools
  - Provides Listening and Spoken Language (LSL) services to children who are Deaf or Hard of Hearing (DHH)
  - Goal of helping children achieve age-appropriate listening, spoken language, speech, and academic skills with the ultimate goal of mainstreaming alongside hearing peers





- Once a week for 15-20 minutes
- Educational team gets together to discuss progress so far, set goals, and address any new information
- Shared with parents at monthly PPC



### Participants

- Teacher(s) for DHH students
- Speech-Language Pathologist(s)
- School Director

- Enrichment teacher(s)
- Related services (OT/PT)
- Outreach Coordinator
- Audiologist



- Tools/Data Sources
  - Newsletter (monthly goals)
    - Data
    - Criterion-referenced norms (CASLLS, TASL)
  - Current audiogram
  - Current information about hearing technology and benefit
  - Calendar of upcoming events
  - Communication from parents



### IKM GUIDELINES

- Meet every week
  - at a set time
  - for a limited time
- Talk about the target student only
  - other children might be on your mind but they have their own IKMs
- WAIT Is this relevant?
