SCHEDULING DIAGNOSTICS PRIOR TO DISCHARGE



1. Baby Refers on NHS



3. Appointment time, date, and clinic location is recorded on the screening results form and reported to EHDI




2. Using EHDI-PALS, the screener schedules a follow-up appointment *WITH* the parents




- 2014 vs 2015 data
- 54% Reduction in LTF Rate






- 2014 vs 2015
- 62% Reduction in LTF Rate






- 2014 vs 2015
- 18% Reduction in LTF Rate






- 2014 vs 2015

- Emphasize the goals of the program
- Show progress
- Give feedback on current PDSA
- Highlight wins
- Remind the staff that someone really is paying attention
- Establish rapport and increase communication




