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


Creating Newborn Hearing Follow-up Strategies Tailored to the Community Served

Goals: Reduce loss to follow-up

Reduce number of days to follow-up

Plan: Create a personalized follow-up strategy based on the region's challenging situation

Assess-Did our strategy help us attain our goal?





Low Ceiling










YKHC and Alaska Native Medical Center are birth hospitals that have tested having children who reside in remote locations. The aim is for each newborn to receive an outpatient screening at the audiology clinic and if necessary diagnostic exam before they return home.

Each facility created a different protocol to implement this immediate follow up process.

YKHC Pre-Maternal and Birth

Expectant mothers must travel to Bethel, one month prior to their due date, to await arrival of their baby.

Baby is born

48 hours-inpatient

Baby & family returns to village

New Personalized Follow-up Strategy

Refer at birth

Contact on-call audiologist to put baby on radar

Repeat screener after 12 hours-Refer

On call audiologist completes natural sleep diagnostic ABR in OB before discharge

Pass>Great

Refer>ANMC Anchorage, AK

Sedated ABR if needed ENT appointment





Protocol Details

Audiologist on-call availability (nights and weekends)

 Protocol training for nursing staff. Audiologist most have sufficient notice that a diagnostic ABR is needed.

Implementation

- Willing audiologist
- Approved HR matters i.e. pay
- OB to Audiology Department open line of communication (TigerText)
- OB nurse training on how to implement protocol



Encourage Stakeholder Interest

YKHC Pediatricians and OB department agreed with implementing protocol and expressed this support to upper administration.



Encourage Stakeholder Interest


With the help of Annette Callies (EHDI Program Manager-AK) we clearly relayed data and expressed message that supported value of implementing personalized NBHS follow up protocol.

YKHC referral rate: 24% June 2019 > 9% End of 2019

National average NBHS referral rate: 4%


Outcomes Birth Screening Referral Rates Reduced





Outcomes

34 babies were screened and/or received a diagnostic ABR prior to discharge between June 1, 2019 and February 1, 2020 by audiologist on-call.



Outcomes

Reduced audiology follow-up appointments. This prevents lost to follow-up due to:

- Weather
- Travel
- DNKAs

Deduction

YKHC region is experiencing success in reducing lost to follow up rates by implementing on call audiology protocol.

Future

- YKHC will continue to implement on-call audiology services for newborn hearing screening protocol.
- Consider training for all audiologists in diagnostic ABR assessment.
- Continue to train travel nurses about the importance of the YKHC NBHS protocol.
- Show evidence of reduced number of days to follow-up and or diagnostic screening.
